

CONFINED SPACE TRAINING

CITY & GUILDS 6160-02 LEVEL 2 AWARD IN WORKING IN MEDIUM RISK CONFINED SPACES



This course is for people who work in medium risk environments and includes preparing to work and entering and exiting confined spaces safely, and using equipment and tools. The aim of this course is to reflect the national occupational standard for a medium risk confined space environment. This course covers both water and non-water industries.

Water: where the operative is working in or near water, or where a confined space is subject to surface water flooding. This may include working with potable water, sewage treatment processes, drain and sewer cleaning operations.

Non-water: this may include pharmaceutical, asbestos removal, vehicle manufacture and servicing, aeronautical, construction, communications, power, utilities, gas, electrical and mechanical engineering and some elements of work operations in mines, quarries and tunnelling.

Learning outcomes:

- **1.** Prepare to work safely in medium risk confined spaces.
- 2. Enter and exit a confined space safely.
- 3. Use equipment and tools safely.
- **4.** Follow working procedures and work safely.
- **5.** Deal with emergencies.
- **6.** Understand the principles of working in medium risk confined spaces.
- **7.** Understand standard protocols for working in medium risk confined spaces
