**Spring Clean nationwide**

We delivered a coordinated, nationwide programme for the Great British Spring Clean 2026, bringing together 79 teammates across five regions. Working alongside local partners, we delivered community litter-picking activities, collecting 250+ bags of litter - more than doubling the target. We also provided equipment to support continued use within local communities.

The Great British Spring Clean is the UK's largest mass-action environmental campaign, bringing together communities to improve local environments.

For 2026, we delivered a coordinated programme of litter-picking activity across five regions, improving shared public spaces and supporting local community priorities.



### Challenges

Activities relied on collaboration with local community partners, who coordinated waste collection and disposal with local councils.

Each activity needed to be safely planned and delivered, including site-specific risk assessments, while aligning to local priorities and ensuring meaningful community impact.

### Solution

We provided the equipment, PPE, structure and coordination needed to deliver safe and effective litter-picking activities across all regions.

By working closely with local partners, each activity was shaped around community needs. Equipment donations were also made to extend the impact beyond the campaign and enable continued use at a local level.

### Our equipment and services supplied at a glance

- Litter picking equipment and PPE supplied

### Result

79 teammates took part across eight regions, collecting 250+ bags of litter - more than doubling the original target of 100. Based on typical collection rates, this equates to an estimated 470kg of waste removed.

The initiative delivered cleaner, safer public spaces and strengthened local engagement. Equipment was also donated to a primary school in Dundee and community partners in the South West & Wales and Midlands regions, enabling continued use.
